

Programs in NJ

NJ Division of Developmental Disabilities (NJ DDD)

The Community Care Waiver (CCW) is a New Jersey program for individuals with developmental disabilities. It pays for the services and supports an individual's needs in order to live in the community.

NJ Personal Preference Program (NJ PPP)

This program offers an alternative way for NJ FamilyCare members qualified for the Personal Care Assistant (PCA) services benefit to remain in their home and stay active in the community.

NJ Assistance for Community Caregiving (JACC)

This program provides in-home and community-based services to individuals age 60+ who meet eligibility requirements. These individuals require assistance with a minimum of 3 daily activities.

Self-Direction in New Jersey



Eligibility

NJ DDD

In the <u>Supports Program</u> –

- Enrolled in only one waiver program
- Age 21+
- Medicaid eligible and functionally eligible for Division services, as defined in Division Circular #3

In the Community Care Program -

- Reachable on the waiting list or determined by the DDD to be at imminent risk of homelessness
- Require Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities Level of Care
- Meet specific Medicaid income and resources tests

NJ PPP

- Approved for Personal Care Assistant Services and needs assistance for at least 6 months
- Able to self-direct services or choose a representative who can act on their behalf

NJ JACC

- Age 60+
- Resides within the community
- Required to receive nursing facility level of care
- Meets financial eligibility requirements
- Not participating in other statefunded programs



Program Benefits

NJ DDD

Offers maximum choice, flexibility and control. Individuals and their service planning team can make decisions about support services and take a direct role in ensuring all services are delivered to their own expectations.

NJ PPP

NJ FamilyCare Plan A members who qualify for PCA services are able to work with a financial consultant to develop a monthly budget. They will have the freedom of choice to determine the services they need and the individuals and/or agencies they wish to hire to provide those identified services.

NJ JACC

Individuals have the choice of staying at home/in their community alongside having the opportunity to direct their own care by hiring their own providers to assist with daily activities.
